Hello lovely Oxnard families. We thank those of you who took the time to give us some feedback for our survey. We really value what you have to say and it helps us shape our program for the future. We are working hard to meet your needs and are doing our best to incorporate as much as we can from the survey. **The survey is now closed.**

A couple of things that we would like to address at this time:

- Please know that we cannot and do not hire parents or relatives of our students as vendors. It has been unfortunately bad practice before, and we stopped that practice a several years ago. We are happy though, if a relative wants to donate his/her time to support our students with a talent he/she has, we would gladly have him/her as volunteer (background check and fingerprinting is always required).
- What we proposed would offer a separate 2nd day for the younger grades (K-5; suggested right now is Tuesday) and for the upper grades (6-12; suggested right now is Wednesday).
- We appreciate you suggesting other vendors for the Oxnard resource center and we will follow up on that. Please keep those suggestions coming.
- We will offer Glass Blowing in Oxnard (it's always about getting the vendor to agree to travel) and we have an amazing Creative Writing class with Jon scheduled (www.creativecoursesforkids.com) that we are sure your students will love. We are also looking at bringing back Robotics with Robotics and Things, which has been rather popular.
- We are looking at providing a lunch break that is greater than the 10 minute passing time. However, if we will do that, and to keep classes on the same schedule, it would be incorporating a study hall time.
- Last but not least, while we appreciate that you love our workshops and classes, please do remember that attending 2-3 full days of workshops and classes means that you need to catch up during the remaining 3 days each week with your work at home to make sure that you are staying on track.
- **Our spring workshop session will start the week of January 22 and run for 9 weeks through the week of March 19. Spring break starts the week of March 26. Please know that a school calendar can be found on our website.**

Counselor's Corner

Community College Registration Information for the Spring, 2018 Semester

As the Spring 2018, semester approaches, it is time to begin the registration process for community college courses. As you know our students may attend community college courses without paying the \$46 per unit tuition (other fees, such as parking, health fee, lab and book fees, may apply). While many of our local community colleges will permit registration for our students in December or January, **Moorpark College** has implemented several changes that will benefit our students:

1. Our students in Grades 9-12 may register for classes beginning **November 22**. This means that students in grades 9 and 10 will no longer need to sit in a class for the first week to gain enrollment. Students below ninth grade will still need the permission of the professor.
2. While students with an existing account at Moorpark (your VCCCD number) are now permitted to upload and submit your dual enrollment form to register, we recommend that you still conduct a walk-in registration on November 22.
3. The Dual Enrollment form for Moorpark now incorporates the Memorandum of Understanding, so that you will need to complete just one form. This form must be signed by River Oaks to gain permission to take your course or courses. You also need to take with you an unofficial transcript, which we will give you upon request.
4. Students in grades are now eligible to take up to 11 units, with the permission of River Oaks.

For detailed information go to www.moorparkcollege.edu, click on "Apply and Enroll," then click on "Apply for Admission." Under New Students, click on "Dual Enrollment," and follow the instructions. If your student has never taken a community college course, the Application for Admission will need to be completed. If he or she already has a VCCCD account, then the process begins with the Dual Enrollment form.

See your teacher, or your Counselor, Richard, for assistance. And remember, this applies to Moorpark College only. See us for help with other colleges.
