



River Oaks Academy Testing Requirements

River Oaks students are expected to participate in the state-mandated and all ROA (local) assessments.

This applies to students in grades 3rd-11th for the academic testing. The state-mandated testing window is in the spring, whereas the ROA (local) assessments are administered 3/year (ROA Assessment #1: at the beginning of each school year or upon entry to ROA; ROA Assessment #2: between the Thanksgiving Break and Winter Break; ROA Assessment #3: in the spring during the state-mandated testing window). ROA uses a State Board of Education approved assessment tool, which is required for charter renewal.

If a parent decides to opt-out his/her student/s from the state-mandated assessment, the parent understands that the student/s will be required to participate in **all** of the ROA (local) assessments **during the ROA set time frame at one of the ROA facilities**. This is considered a teacher assignment. **Parents are not allowed to opt-out of the ROA (local) assessments.**

Should the student not be made available during the ROA established testing window for the ROA (local) assessments, the teacher will be implementing the MAR (Missed Assignment Report) procedures, following the Academic Probation Policy. Missing or not finishing the required ROA (local) testing during the assigned time-frame may mean that the student could lose his/her spot with River Oaks.
